1 General Terms and Conditions of Participation

By registering for an event organized by Union MTB Club Koppl, participants acknowledge and accept Terms and Conditions of Participation as well as the disclaimer regarding personal injury, property damage, or any other losses arising from participation.

Participants confirm that all information provided during registration is accurate and complete and that they have read and understood the event announcement, disclaimer, terms and conditions, and the Cycling Austria regulations.

Registration is only possible upon acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

The Austrian Distance and Off-Premises Contracts Act (FAGG) does not apply to contracts concluded with the Organizer in connection with this sporting event. Consequently, no statutory withdrawal period applies.

Each registration becomes binding immediately upon confirmation by the Organizer or its Organizing Committee.

2 Participation Requirements and Applicable Regulations

Extract from the Regulations for National Championships:

„10.1.01 Only the following riders are eligible to participate in the National Championships (Austrian National Championships / Austrian Championships in Road, Criterium, Cyclo-cross, Track, Cross-Country, Eliminator, Short Track and Pump Track (Dual)):

a. all Austrian citizens and dual citizens holding a valid Cycling Austria license.

b. all Austrian citizens and dual citizens holding a valid foreign license.

Reasons preventing the granting of a starting permission for dual citizens:

participation in championships organized by other UCI member federations during the respective season.

10.1.08 Medals at National Championships shall only be awarded if at least four participants start in the respective individual event.

10.1.09 If the minimum number of starters specified for the respective categories and events is not reached, the corresponding event shall not be held.“

3 Collection and Storage of Personal Data

As a participant, I voluntarily consent to the collection, processing, and storage of my personal data provided during registration. Personal data will be stored electronically on secure servers in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and applicable Austrian data protection legislation. The Organizer may process and publish the following information for sporting and organizational purposes: First name, Last name, Gender, Club or team name, Year of birth, Age category, Race time, Ranking and results, Race number. This information may be published in start lists, participant lists, result lists, printed publications, websites, social media platforms, and electronic media. Personal data may also be shared with service providers involved in the organization of the event, including official timing providers such as Time2Win. By providing an email address, participants agree that the Organizer may use this address to communicate information relating to the event. Any necessary inquiries may be conducted via the telephone number provided during registration.

4 Event Risks and Participant Responsibilities

As a participating athlete, I am aware that the practice of mountain biking, particularly when striving for outstanding performance, involves risks and that competitive sport may entail significant physical, psychological and technical stress and hazards. These risks are diverse and may result from outer conditions, public roads and trails, natural and artificial obstacles, as well as from other race participants.

I have carefully considered these risks and expressly accept them by participating in this sporting activity. As a participant, I shall not assert any claims against the organizers, sponsors, their representatives, or the landowners for damages or injuries of any kind that may arise from my participation. Furthermore, upon entering the sports facility and throughout my stay, I undertake to comply with all applicable legal provisions, the venue regulations, and the general rules and regulations of the national sports federation responsible for the sport being conducted. I acknowledge that the operator of the sports facility and/or the organizer is entitled to monitor compliance with the above-mentioned regulations. This includes, in addition to maintaining booking, access and attendance systems and records, the use of security personnel and/or video surveillance (see the Organizer's Privacy Policy contained in this document). Furthermore, I undertake to immediately comply with any instructions issued by the operator of the sports facility, the organizer of the sporting activity, or any authorized third party for the purpose of enforcing the above regulations. In case of Failure and disciplinary misbehavior it may result in removal from the sports facility and/or exclusion from participation in the sporting activity. I undertake to comply immediately with any such removal or exclusion. In the event of non-compliance with or without violation of the contents of this declaration of consent, I shall be liable towards the operator of the sports facility and/or the organizer. I agree to the promoter and the operator of the sports facility and/or the organizer from any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs or legal actions brought by third parties as a result of my violation of this declaration through my entry, presence and/or conduct at the sports facility, regardless of the reason. By starting the race, I acknowledge the safety measures properly implemented by the organizer to secure the race course. By starting the race, I declare that I consider the condition and degree of difficulty of the technical course and race course to be suitable for me and that the technical equipment selected by me on my own responsibility is suitable for these competition conditions.

I further declare that I have trained sufficiently for participation in this MTB competition, that I am physically healthy and capable of enduring the demands of the event, and that I protect myself by wearing a helmet complying with ANSI, Snell, TÜV, GS and/or UCI standards.

5 Media Rights and Copyright

I agree that photographs, video recordings, interviews, media reports, and other materials created in connection with my participation may be used, published, reproduced, and distributed by the Promoter without compensation or further approval. This consent applies to all forms of media, including print publications, websites, social media channels, television broadcasts, and promotional materials. I further confirm that all information provided during registration is accurate and complies with the event regulations. I understand that violations of event regulations, including manipulation or modification of official race numbers, may result in disqualification. I accept the applicable participation conditions, payment obligations, entry fees, and any insurance requirements related to the event. As this event constitutes a leisure activity service, no right of withdrawal or cancellation exists once registration has been completed. No refund of entry fees will be granted for any reason, including non-participation.

6 Disclaimer

The event is covered by the Union Sport Insurance program, including liability insurance, legal protection insurance, and accident insurance. Each participant remains fully responsible for their own equipment and personal belongings. The Promoter is not responsible to inspect, maintain, supervise, or secure participant equipment. Accordingly, no claims may be asserted against the Promoter for loss, theft, damage, or deterioration of personal property, including bicycles, clothing, accessories, or equipment. Any costs incurred from emergency services, medical transport, rescue operations, or similar third-party services shall be borne by the participant. Should such costs initially be charged to the Promoter, he himself reserves the right to recover these costs from the respective participant. Participants must also comply with all official requirements and agreements with landowners associated with the event, including restrictions regarding riding the course before or after the official race program. In the event of cancellation, interruption, postponement, or modification of the event due to weather conditions, safety concerns, official orders, or circumstances beyond the Organizer's control, participants shall not be entitled to compensation, reimbursement, rescheduling, or repetition of the event.
